



3 Gun League

Goals:

Our goal is to make this league as approachable as possible while providing a safe and fun experience.

Outlaw Rules:

Any choice of weapon with any combination of accessories qualifies a shooter. You must use a primary, secondary, and shotgun. Safety is our #1 rule.

- Event Fee: \$20 CASH. No credit cards or checks are accepted. Each shooter can enter twice per match if time allows.
- Members pay the \$20 event fee. Non-members must purchase a \$10 daily pass or join as a member.

Schedule:

1. 27 May 2023 – **Themed: John Wick Match**
2. 17 June 2023
3. 22 July 2023 – **Themed: Zombie Match**
4. 19 August 2023
5. 02 September 2023 – **Themed: Combat Match**
6. 23 September 2023 – **Themed: Knock-Out Match**

4 lanes per match

- 0700 – Setup
- 0800 – Registration Opens
- 0900 – Match Start
- 1500 – Estimated Match End and Tear Down

Theme Guidelines

- Theme participation is optional for competitors
- Participate in the theme and get 2 league points per themed match

General Weapon Rules

- A “**Division**” is defined as a single set of weapons composed of a primary, secondary, and shotgun.
 - Competitors must use the same three weapons per “division”.
 - Competitors can compete in, and pay for, up to two divisions per match (depending on time).
 - If competing in two divisions, the competitor must declare this, and pay for the second division, during registration at the **start** of the match.
- Steel ammunition is **NOT** allowed. No steel BB’s in shotgun shells. (IT WILL DAMAGE THE STEEL TARGETS)
- There is **NO LIMIT** on the type, amount, or magnification of any optics used on any weapon.
- Suppressors **ARE ALLOWED** as long as they register with the shot timer.
- Full-auto weapons are **NOT** allowed.
- The use of a sling **IS AUTHORIZED** on all weapons.
- The use of a bipod on your primary weapon **IS AUTHORIZED**.
- Competitors can only use magazines on their person during their run. A competitor can have as many magazines on their person as they want.

Safety is our #1 goal. Safety violations will not be tolerated and handled on a case-by-case basis per RO’s involved.
